PARENT-TEACHER CONFERENCES

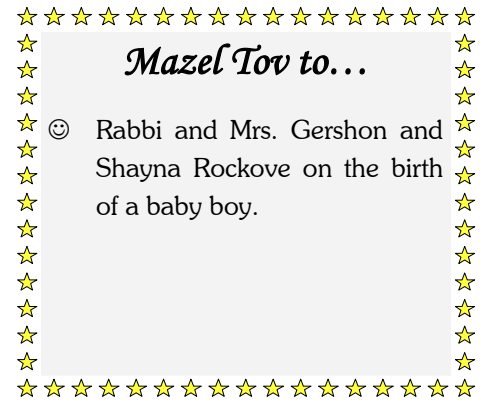

- The instructions for conference sign-up are on the last page of the Chai Lights. Please follow them carefully. If you have any questions while you are signing up, please call Mrs. Friedman at the Boys' School office, 314-727-3335 (until 12:30) and she will be happy to help you.
- **IMPORTANT FOR EVERYONE: Even though the system will give you the option, each family may sign up for only one 10 minute conference slot per teacher, no matter how many children in your family have that particular teacher.**

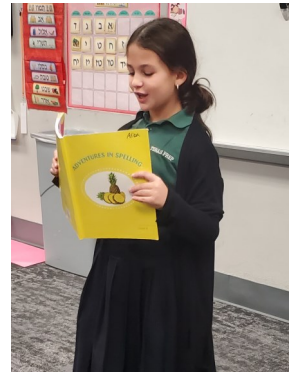
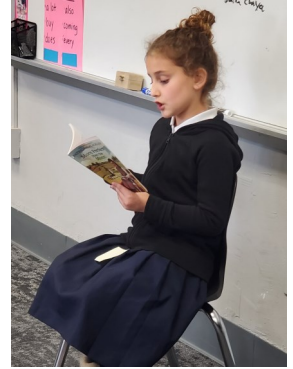

Mrs. Wolk's Kindergarten-4th graders enjoy PE



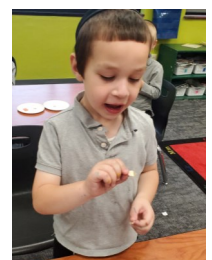

Mrs. Frank's third graders....

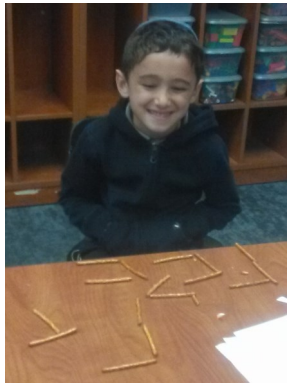

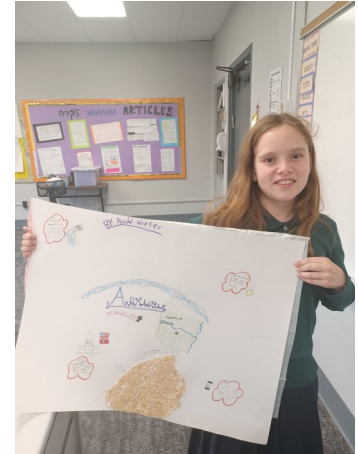
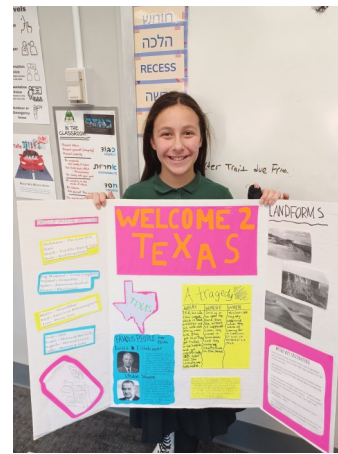
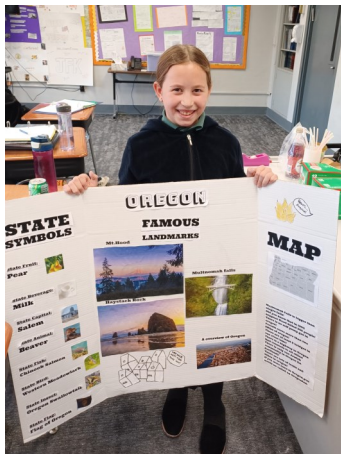
There is so much excitement going on in Morah Anton's Kindergarten classroom. Pictured are the boys using edibles to create the many Alef Bais letters they know



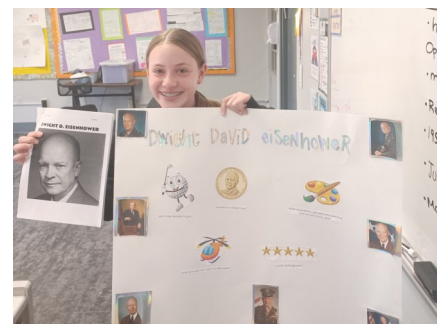
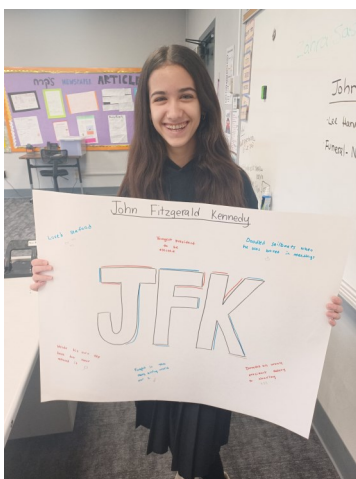
Mrs. Bromberg's 6th grade Social Studies class began presentations as part of their study of The Industrial Revolution. Malka Rosner presented on the cotton gin.

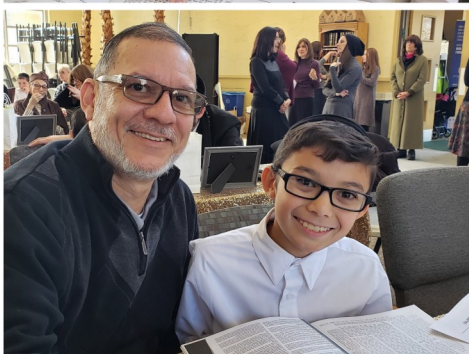
This past Sunday, Rabbi Glazer's sixth grade reached the milestone of Haschalas Gemara!! All mothers and fathers, plus many grandparents and even two great-grandmothers, were in attendance to shep Yiddishe nachas at this special event.

Rabbi Golombeck opened the program with a message to the boys that ameilus b'Torah is what really counts and a message to the parents to take advantage of the power of Tefillah for their son's success in learning. The assemblage then had the zchus of watching two short videos of Divrei Bracha from HaRav Aharon Feldman shlita, Rosh Yeshiva Yeshivas Ner Yisroel, and HaRav Yaakov Bender shlita, Rosh Yeshiva Yeshivas Darchei Torah. Rabbi Greenblatt shlita offered personal Divrei Bracha to the boys and their families and presented each boy with their very first gemara— Eilu Metzios. The program continued with fathers and sons enjoying a spirited learning seder, truning the room into an active Beis Medrash. Finally, the program concluded with Rabbi Glazer leading the boys in a singing performance of "Ba'avur Avoseinu". Music and dancing followed as well as everyone enjoying the beautiful buffet prepared by the N'shei Chayil mothers of the class. 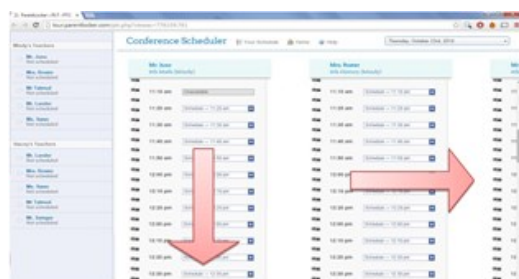

Scheduling Parent-Teacher Conference Meetings

Follow these steps to quickly and easily schedule Parent-Teacher Conference meetings on ParentLocker.

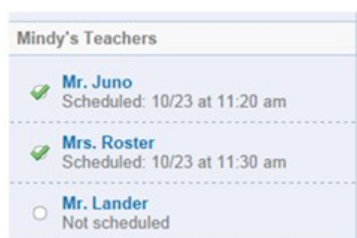
1. Login to ParentLocker by going to your school's login screen and entering your email address and password.
2. On the left side of the homepage, under the Torah Prep logo, click "P/T Conferences."
3. Once inside the Conference Scheduler, select the date you want to schedule for from the drop-down menu on the upper right hand side of the page.
4. You will now see a list of teachers available on the date you selected, and their conference schedule below their name.
 - o Scroll down to see more times.
 - o Scroll to the right to see more of your child's teachers. Click a teacher's name from the list on the left side of the screen to jump directly to that teacher's schedule.



When you find a time you want to reserve with a teacher, click the "Schedule" button near the time. **Each family may sign up for only one 10 minute conference slot per teacher, no matter how many children in your family have that particular teacher, even though the system will give you the option to sign up for each child with that teacher.**

5. The system won't let you schedule more than one meeting in a single time slot or when the teacher is unavailable.

As you schedule meetings, a green check mark will appear near the teacher's name on the left side of the screen.



6. Once you have scheduled all your meetings, click the "Your Schedule" button on top to view your schedule. There you can print your schedule to bring to conferences with you and also email it to yourself.
